

Public libraries and school districts are partnering to remove barriers and provide all students with the opportunity to access the materials available to them at the public library. The Student Library Card allows students to explore and utilize the many free resources including traditional books, virtual programming and innovative and engaging educational and entertainment resources.*

The library card allows students to:

- Borrow materials from any library in Allegheny County
- Access databases to assist with school research and supplement resources available at the school library or media center
- Use public library computers at any location in Allegheny County
- Request books from any library in Allegheny County
- Use and download eBooks and other electronic resources



IMPORTANT FACTS

- 1. While the school district will share basic data with the public library including the student's name, address, date of birth, student ID and homeroom (for distribution), the library is obligated not share the information with any other parties. If you do not want your child's information shared, please complete the opt-out form distributed by the school district.
- 2. If your child already has a library card, it will be updated and the student ID number will be added to the record.
- 3. Depending on the policies of the library located within your school district and the type of card distributed, fines may accrue. Not all libraries are fine free and not all library cards provide limited, fine-free student access.

* Card restrictions may be different depending on the library and school district.
